Student Welcome Letter and Class Policies and Procedures:

At Jet Set University, we strive to give you the best dog training experience possible with our knowledgeable instructors who have years of experience in the dog sport, and strive to make classes fun, informative and a great place for your dog(s).

Classes at JSU are typically one hour in length and run for 4 weeks, each new session starting at the beginning of the month. Classes are specified on the class schedule.

Supplies/Information for Class Participation:

- Please bring a Hungry Dog, we ask that you hold off feeding your dog before class as food will be the primary reinforcer to start your training.
- Make sure your dog has had an appropriate time to go to the bathroom. If you have signed up for an agility class that takes place in the arena, we have a turf accident policy. Should your dog have an accident during class, please inform your instructor so it can be sanitized.
- Collars allowed: Flat Buckle Collar, Martingale, Slip Collar, Prong or gentle leader
- Leashes: 6 foot leash or shorter; Traffic leads preferred, NO flexi's, No Longlines
- Treat bag filled with plenty of food rewards ie. Small kibble, Cheese cubes, Hot dogs, Happy Howie's Training Treat Logs, etc.
- Please bring your dog's favorite interactive toy (Tug, Frisbee, Tennis Ball, Squeaky Toy, etc)
- Poop bags
- Crate: Wire, Plastic, Metal, Soft-sided

General Rules for Safety:

- DO NOT use any agility equipment without the permission and observation of the instructor. THIS is so important. Using equipment without proper knowledge can be dangerous and could impact the positive learning of the equipment for the dog.
- Keep your dog focused on you when out of their crate and mind other dogs' space
- DO NOT let your dog greet another dog – Do not assume all dogs are friendly even if your dog is
- Follow your trainer's instructions; please keep your dog quiet when trainer is speaking
- Please walk your dog outside on leash only and away from the building to relieve themselves, and always clean up after your dog
- Make sure your dog is crated or under control when another dog is running
- Please wear appropriate footwear: NO bare feet, flip flops or heeled shoes

Regulations and JSU House Rules:

Children and teenagers are welcome at our facility subject to the following guidelines:

Children under 9 may come to classes, if supervised outside the training arena by a legal guardian who is not handling the dog.

Children 16 and older, at the instructor's discretion, may train their dog without legal guardian present.

Please do not let your dog eliminate on the building, landscaping or trash cans. Dog waste stations are located around the premises.

Females in season are allowed in advanced level agility classes only with panties.

Please bring your class registration form, proof of rabies and payment to the first week of class. If you miss a class, inform your instructor so they can tell you what you missed. There are NO make-up classes unless specified by instructor. Classes are sold as a package and we do not offer refunds if you miss a class. We pay the instructor based on the class we build.
